

## Diploma of Remedial Massage (HLT50307)

### RPL/Credit Transfer Qualification Requirements

The HLT50307 Diploma of Remedial Massage comprises *14 units packaged a 6 Common Units, 5 Specialisation Unit and 3 Elective units*. The HLT50307 Diploma of Remedial Massage specifies the competencies required to deliver training in an industry area or area of subject matter expertise, and to conduct competency based assessment in a range of contexts.

#### 3 Easy steps to gaining RPL

**Step 1** – Complete this form and submit it with all relevant documentation to support your claim for RPL.

**Step 2** – Once ACFB receive these documents, we will then map out any RPL you are entitled to and work out an amended price for your course and a cost for the RPL process, which usually takes 10-14 days.

*Please note; Even if a full course RPL is awarded, there is still a cost for the RPL process.*

*~ Some students may also require an additional RPL process, which may include practical demonstrations and/or assessments. Students will be made aware of these requirements at this stage.*

**Step 3** – Once you have agreed to the RPL awarded, please complete an Application Form and we can then get you started in your course!

**To be awarded an RPL/RCC for specific units in the HLT50307 Diploma of Remedial Massage the following requirements are to be submitted for processing in an organised Evidence Portfolio.**

The portfolio must be submitted to your trainer along with the application form (attached) and must address:

- ✚ A certified copy of any previous Certificate (if relevant) and any other qualifications held relevant to the Diploma of Remedial Massage
- ✚ A combination / a selection of the following as evidence to support the additional requirements. This may include:
  - A signed letter from your manager stating that you have worked previously or are currently working within a Massage facility.
  - An up-to-date resume detailing qualifications and experience relevant to the Diploma of Remedial Massage
  - Examples of any massage treatments you have given and implemented for a client including assessment, re-assessment and progress evaluation.
